The I/N Crowd – By **Rod Bias**



*Read Books — You Should
Read Books (Part 1 of 2)*

I used to give away books ... lotsa books. Then I discovered not everyone learns from books. Looking back, most of the books I gave away were probably never read by those to whom I gave them.

I know a Gold Life Master in Scottsdale who has never taken a bridge lesson or read a bridge book. I get the part about lessons. Most of what I know about bridge, I learned from books. If you don't learn by reading, take classes. Here's my list of top books for I/N players:

Card Play Fundamentals by Blackwood & Hanson Clear & Short: 120 pages. This is a very simple overview of how to win the most tricks with the fewest points.

First Principles of Card Play by Paul Marston: Covers exactly the same ground as Blackwood but uses different terminology and is in more depth: 154 pages. Read Blackwood first (quickly) and then Marston.

Monster Book of Basic Declarer Play by Huggett & Cashmore: Three-page review of what you learned about declarer play in notrump from the two books above: 80 easy notrump deals, step-by-step. Three-page review of what you learned about declarer play in trump from the two books above: 80 easy trump deals, step-by-step. Three-pages of what you can learn from their bidding when you become declarer: 80 easy deals, mixed trump and notrump. Put this book in your bathroom! Seriously! You know you go in there every day. Read two pages every day, and in four months you will have read the book.

Read Books — You Should Read Books

Bridge for Dummies by Eddie Kantar No bidding in the first 100+ pages. He teaches you how to win tricks. Here are two great Newcomer books and two Intermediate books you might want to add to your bridge bookshelf. Let me know when you locate a book that boosts your scores. I'll read it and add it to this list.

Declarer Play by Zia Mahmood. It covers the same concepts as the Blackwood or Marston books using another vocabulary. Knowing how to execute a particular tactic is more important than what you call it.

Defence by Zia Mahmood. Learn how to take more tricks from your opponents when they declare and set them more often. Defence demands partnership cooperation. If you have a regular partner(s), you can benefit by working through Section 4 (chapters 10-12) "Teamwork" together. Do this with each regular partner.

Bridge: The Basic Elements of Play and Defence by G.C.H. Fox. Explore intermediate card-play concepts such as: Avoidance, Safe Hand / Danger Hand, Timing, Inevitable Losers, Loser-on-Loser, When Not to Draw Trumps, and When and How to Draw Trumps.

Bridge: Winning Ways to Play Your Cards by Paul Mendelson. Essential strategies for declarer and defense are the focus. This invaluable guide helps to assess your opponents' strengths and weaknesses in relation to your own — and win! Read this book after you read any other book on this list. Mastering these intermediate-level tactics will improve your skills and scores. **I have a few used** copies of all these books.

I/N Corner Tip

Not all points are created equal

We all use the point count to help make bidding decisions. However, don't be a slave to it. Here's an example:

You open 1♠ and partner raises to 2♠. Which of the following hands is better?

♠AK532 ♥AK532 ♦32 ♣2

or

♠K8532 ♥98532 ♦AK ♣A

Both hands have 14 points, but Hand #1 is much better. Why? Because it will almost always take more tricks than hand #2. You don't believe me? Try to play a 4♠ contract opposite the following typical dummies:

Hand 1

♠Q76 ♥Q76 ♦Q76 ♣Q765

♠AK532 ♥AK532 ♦32 ♣2

Hand 2

♠Q76 ♥Q76 ♦Q76 ♣Q765

♠K8532 ♥98532 ♦AK ♣A

With hand #1 you'll make 10 tricks about half the time (losing two diamonds and one club). With hand #2 you'll be lucky to make 9 tricks (probably losing three hearts and two spades. What's the point? When you're evaluating your offensive potential, having *high cards in your long suits* is better for taking tricks. That's the bottom line, isn't it?
