*Be the Wonderful Partner
You'd Like to Have (Part 1)*

Have you read *Working Together: Why Great Partnerships Succeed* by Michael Eisner? The former Disney CEO discusses how and why partnerships succeed. Eisner tells the stories of nine highly successful business and entertainment collaborations. The epilogue (“Happiness”) begins: “You have probably never heard of Jeff Meckstroth and Eric Rodwell.”

Why did Eisner wrap up his book with Meckwell Magic from the world of bridge? Quite simply, good bridge requires partnership skills. It ain’t the cards — it’s how well you and your partners “click.”

You might call it “chemistry.” Bridge partnerships are like dance partnerships. You have to move together: swing and sway, zig and zag. Jeff and Eric have been playing as partners for decades and decades. Explore what makes great partnerships work well.

Here are a few suggestions from Lynn Bartz:

Respect and Trust One Another. Remember what Jesus said: *Do unto others as you would have them do unto you.* Demonstrate your respect for your partner with common courtesy. Never say anything negative in front of the opponents. Always “have your partner’s back.” Trust every bid, signal and play your partner makes. Yes, at times, you both will (and should) lie to your partner *for the good of the partnership.* You meet partner at the game feeling like road kill; partner says, “How’s it going?” You smile and say/lie, “Wonderful” for the good of the partnership. Always huddle *away from the*

bridge table and discuss misunderstandings. *Analyze Your Mistakes.* Get “hand records” and discuss each deal, one-by-one. Don’t just look at your bad results ... look at your good results, too. Did you earn your good result or did the other side give it to you? To be a constant winner you have to work at it ... it doesn’t just happen. You have to understand bridge. That takes time and experience. Mishaps, mistakes, errors happen. Avoid them and your score goes up, up, up.

◆ *Respect and Trust One Another*

◆ *Analyze Your Mistakes*

Communicate Well and Often. You love to play 12-14 notrump openings; your partner does not. You think your partner “saves” too often; partner disagrees. What do you do when you don’t see eye-to-eye? The important thing is to talk about it and come to terms you can both live with. This requires honesty and often compromise.

Here’s one way to compromise:

Agree to do it (whatever “it” is) both ways for the next six months and agree to revisit the topic then. For six months, you alternate — do it one person’s way on odd months and the other one’s way one even months! Then stop and talk it over again.

Focus on the Good Stuff. Treat your partner with respect; as an equal. Tell them exactly what you appreciate about them.

“Appreciation is a wonderful thing. It makes what is excellent in others belong to us as well” (Voltaire). When you show appreciation, you gain something and take nothing.

Inject your appreciation of partner into a conversation with someone else. You don’t have to be too serious. Don’t do it too often. Just drop it casually into a conversation once in a while. “My partner makes killer opening leads.” “My partner seems to be straining to land a game contract ... and then brings it in with an overtrick.” “My partner always knows how to defuse tension

at the table.” What do you like most about your partner? Think about it. Talk about it. Celebrate your victories and achievements ... big and small.

Keep the Excitement Going. Share new insights from books, experts, etc. It will improve your partnership. Experiment with new things. Upside-down signals are easy to adopt and almost surely superior to standard signals. Take classes together. Each of you should actively seek a Mentor and share with your partner what you are learning from your Mentor. Occasionally play with other partners. It helps you discover what you appreciate about your regular partner.

I/N Corner Tip 2

Scottsdale, Arizona

Here's a little quiz for you. Your right-hand opponent opens 1♦. What do you do with each of the following hands?

#1, ♠QJ52 ♥AK53 ♦3 ♣K862

#2. ♠AKJ53 ♥985 ♦A63 ♣K8

#3. ♠QJ52 ♥AK53 ♦K862 ♣3

Hand 1. This is a classic takeout double, asking partner to bid her longest unbid suit. The requirements for a takeout double:

- ♦ An opening hand, usually 12 or more high-card points, perhaps 11 with perfect distribution
- ♦ Shortness in the suit opened (diamonds in this case)
- ♦ Support for the three unbid suits (at least three in each)

Hand 2. Overcall 1♠. Depending upon the vulnerability, this usually shows about 10 to 17 points with a good 5-card suit. Note that an overcall can be a pretty good hand; you don't need to double to show your points.

Hand 3. Pass. You should have a 5-card suit to overcall, and a takeout double promises support for all the unbid suits. How happy would you be if you double, and partner bids 2♣ (or 3♣)? It's not always necessary to bid. On this hand, it's likely that the opponents will struggle to find a good spot to play. Why help them out?
